1. Give God your voice to _____.

“They were all struck with astonishment and *began* glorifying God; and they were filled with fear, saying, “We have seen remarkable things today.” *Luke 5:26 (NASB)*

“Fear gripped them all, and they *began* glorifying God, saying, “A great prophet has arisen among us!” and, “God has visited His people!” *Luke 7:16 (NASB)*

“And He laid His hands on her; and immediately she was made erect again and *began* glorifying God.” *Luke 13:13 (NASB)*

2. Give God your voice to _____ other people.

“We urge you, brethren, admonish the unruly, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with everyone.” *1 Thessalonians 5:14 (NASB)*

“Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.” *Ephesians 4:29 (ESV)*

“Worry weighs a person down; an encouraging word cheers a person up.” *Proverbs 12:25 (NLT2)*

3. Give God your voice to _____ the good news.

“So never be ashamed to tell others about our Lord. And don’t be ashamed of me, either, even though I’m in prison for him. With the strength God gives you, be ready to suffer with me for the sake of the Good News.” *2 Timothy 1:8 (NLT2)*
